# NOTICE OF COUNCIL CONSIDERATION OF ZONING AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 2436

The District of Peachland Council is considering Application Z24-02 to rezone 6448 Renfrew Rd on April 8, 2025 at 6:00 pm. This proposal is in conformance with the Official Community Plan, and Council is not permitted to hold a public hearing for the application as per Section 464 (3) of the *Local Government Act*.

#### PURPOSE OF PROPOSAL

Zoning Bylaw Amendment No. 2436 is a proposal to rezone the above noted property from Rural Residential (RR1) to Multi-Unit Infill Residential (RM2). To facilitate future a subdivision.

A Public Hearing will not be held for the proposed zoning amendment bylaw pursuant to s.464 of the *Local Government Act* as the purpose of the proposed bylaw is to permit residential development and is consistent with the District's Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 2220.
